Fish Camp is returning this year!

Campers will go fishing every day! Survivor Kids is a new camp that takes surviving in the wild to a whole new level. Your child will learn how to access water from the earth and sky. Jr. Naturalist Camp will have your camper jumping like a frog one day and doing the dragonfly bop the next! During "CSI" camp, be prepared to be slimed! Explore your creative side in Nature Art Camp. At Metea County Park, campers explore cedar creek from the center of a tire tube! Back Country Camp Skills & Campfire Cooking campers will learn how to set up camp as well as how to cook while enjoying camp life! Each year we try to change the activities offered for each camp. ## Registration

Registration deadline is two weeks prior to each camp. Early bird deadline is **May 21, 2010.**

Complete all questions on the registration form. If you are registering for more than one camper or session, please photocopy the form to create an individual registration form for each camper and session. Registrations are accepted in the order in which they are received. Full payment is required for us to reserve your spot. If a program is full (maximum of 30 campers per session), a waiting list will be created. A confirmation brochure will be sent to you after your camper's registration payment is received. ## Payments/Deposits

Camp Cost: \$100.00 per week per child. Payments is due two weeks prior to camp. Sack lunches *from home* are required. We will provide drinks and snacks. Go green and bring a re-usable, labeled, water bottle. The early-bird rate (for registrations received prior to May 21, 2010) is \$95.00 per camper. Golden Parks Pass holder's registration fee is \$90.00 per camper. Checks payable to: ***Allen County Parks***. Returned checks are subject to a \$25 return check fee. Refunds are subject to management approval.

**Pre-registration is required. No walk-in registrations the day of camp will be taken.**
