- ❖ Provide an educational opportunity for course participants by volunteering with a local agency or organization involved in natural resource management.
- ❖ In Allen County Indiana, this program is sponsored by Fox Island Alliance, Allen County Parks & PFW Environmental Resource Center.

Program Information:

The sessions begin on Tuesday, February 22nd & end on Saturday, May 28th with a Native Tree Hike at Metea Park.

The **Orientation Meeting** on Tuesday evening, February 22nd is a required part of the program.

Participants **must** complete at least 8 classes of the 13 classes offered plus the Orientation, complete weekly quizzes, and accumulate 24 hours of volunteer work to obtain Indiana Master Naturalist Certification and a pin. Any session that includes an academic presentation on Tuesday and a hike on Saturday is considered ONE session.

Class size is limited to 25 applicants. Space is reserved on a **first-come first-served basis.**

Hiking sessions will require moderate walking.

Important: Your registration fee will be returned if we are unable to reserve a space for you, or if you drop the class before the Orientation.

Money may not be returned after orientation unless there are extenuating circumstances. These non-refundable fees can be applied to future IMN either in Allen County or at other IMN state sites.
