Is Fox Island worth becoming a "Natural Landmark"?

While park staff have been busy prepping several of the interior spaces of our nature center this month, more historical treasures were revealed. I found an "Evaluation of Fox Island Allen County, Indiana for eligibility for Registered Natural Landmark", prepared by Dr. Marion T. Jackson, Professor of Life Sciences at Indiana State University, May, 1973. You may remember Dr. Jackson as the editor for the book: "The Natural Heritage of Indiana". This book was the first survey of the natural beauty and environmental problems of the state of Indiana. The book is illustrated with photographs by the some of the state's best nature photographers. It contains essays by 38 of Indiana's notable scholars and environmental protectors.

Upon recommendation by the Director of the Northwest Region of the National Park Service, Dr. Jackson spent most of the day on Friday, June 30th, 1972, photographing and completing an on-site inspection of the Fox Island area. "In addition, Chapter 83 of Natural Areas of Indiana and Their Preservation was reviewed. Study reports and species lists compiled by Mr. Robert Weber, botany teacher at Fort Wayne South Side High School and his students; Dr. John Klotz and his students at Concordia Senior College, Ft. Wayne, Indiana 46825; and by J. Edward Parrot, University of Dallas, were valuable aids in preparing this report."

At this time, the tract known as Fox Island was 200 acres owned by the Allen County Park Board. Proposed acquisitions hoped to increase the area to just over one square mile. We have achieved 605 acres as of November 20th, 2024.

Dr. Jackson states that "the old growth black oak-dominated forest on the dunal ridge has apparently never been cut. Some parts of the stand (particularly in the East section) have smaller trees and abundant aspen in the canopy." He suggests that "such areas were likely opened by windthrow or fire several years ago. Most of the marshland appears

unmodified from the original situation, although some lowering of the water table may have resulted from the Graham-McCulloch Drainage Ditch." He goes on to describe the borrow pit (Bowman Lake) was dug when I-69 was built. "A pine plantation of a few acres is located near the entry lane in the south sector. Most of the trees are scotch pine ranging in height from 15-25 feet". This indicates a Christmas tree planting. Much of the western section and some of the southern and eastern portions are in old field and early woodland seral stages. Grazing and an active dairy farm was in the area. The land being used for crop land is listed as "doubtful due to the droughty sandy or poorly-drained lowland soils."

Dr. Jackson mentions a few "dangers to the integrity of the area": "For several years abandoned automobiles have been left at several locations within the Fox Island area by irresponsible people." The "bullet-ridden nature of these derelict cars attests to the frequency of visits by hunters and target shooters." Unfortunately, it gets worse. He states that the "greatest destruction is presently being wrought by trail motorcycles and other all-terrain vehicles (ATV's). Three teen-aged cyclists were churning the Plainfield sandy soil into a miniature dust bowl the day I (Dr. Jackson) was there. They showed complete disregard for foot traffic and attempted to crowd me away from the trail. Entire plant communities and soil profiles were being ground up by the tires and in at least one location a cycle jump had been created by excavating into the hillside." "Mosquitoes presented a serious annoyance in the heavy woods, even when mid-day in mid-summer."

On a positive note Jackson stated: "The outstanding ecological and education value of Fox Island lies in its great habitat diversity. The entire moisture spectrum from open water to sand dunes is represented, with complete hydrospheres (open water) and xeroseres (dry sand dunes) available within close proximity. Nowhere in Indiana except at Lake Michigan Dunes is such a range of habitat conditions represented within such a small area."

The black oak (*Quercus velutina*)—dominated forest on the Plainfield sandy soil presented a near-maximum forest development for such a xeric (dry sandy) site. The largest tree at the site was 43.2" dbh (diameter at breast height) near the entrance lane. This was most likely his description of our beloved old black oak that was felled by the Derecho storm of 2022. Species noted were prickly ash, wild sarsaparilla, alum root, Indian cucumber-root, glaucous spiderwort and cinnamon fern. The wetlands included open water and extensive marsh with both small and large duckweeds floating on the water on June 30, 1972. The marsh was dominated by cattail, swamp dock, bulrush, and water-plantain. The open meadows including old-field grasses and forbs including huge colonies of brown-eyed Susans and Venus' looking glass. A survey of spring flora by members of Bob Weber's biology class listed the common forest and meadow species plus unusual species such as skunk cabbage, wild columbine, marsh marigold, and trailing arbutus.

A bird list provided by Edward Parrot listed 83 species, including 3 raptors and 12 species of warblers. We now have 218 bird species listed on eBird. Dr. Jackson states the "environmental educational potential of the tract is enormous since it is the only large natural area within the hour's drive of the ½ million residents of the area."

Due to the features described here, Dr. Jackson placed it "in good stead for inclusion in the National Landmark program."

Presently, the Fox Island Nature Preserve will have amendments made to the Master Plan of the Fox Island Nature Preserve. The public hearing for these amendments was held on December 9th, 2024, at 10:00AM in Fox Island's Vera Dulin Wildlife Observation Building. These amendments allow for:

- 1.) The removal of coarse woody debris with equipment on tracks, such as a feller-buncher or track loader, to allow access by managers, and for the removal of heavy fuel in areas where native grasses will be planted as fuel for prescribed burns.
- 2.) Aggressive management of invasive and weeding plant species, both native and non-native, will be removed in areas where their heavy presence within those areas will compete with the desired forest ecosystem, such as a black oak savannah or an Oak-Hickory climax forest.
- 3.) In some areas prescribed burning will remove unwanted natives. Aggressive invasive species management will be utilized by using both physical and chemical methods such as pulling, cutting/mowing, digging, trapping and pesticides in areas where they become undesirable to achieve the desired forest ecosystem.
- **4.)** Hunting and trapping under the laws of the State of Indiana may be permitted within the Nature Preserve with the written approval of the Director of the Division of Nature Preserves, in order to control problems of overpopulation of specific animal species. It is understood that this Nature Preserve is intended foremost as a refuge for wildlife and plant communities, and that **such action may only be taken when specific animal populations threaten to degrade the natural integrity of the Nature Preserve by substantially decreasing other plant and animal populations.**

Upcoming Programs for Winter

Program fees are usually \$3.00 per person cash or check only unless otherwise stated. Most programs require pre-registration to allow resource and staff allocation planning. There may be requirements for a minimum number registered to offer the program. You will be notified at least 1 day before the program if it has been cancelled due to minimum registrations not being met.
