Who's Your Daddy (Longlegs)?

In the last newsletter, the article about Nature Misconceptions mentioned daddy-longlegs/harvestmen “spiders” and how they are different than common knowledge says they are. We’ll dive a little deeper into the subject now.

These animals are in the order Opiliones, which includes over 6,650 species worldwide organized in five suborders. While they are in the Class Arachnida with spiders, and though they might look like spiders, they are more closely related to scorpions and horseshoe crabs. Unlike spiders, most only have one pair of eyes located in the middle of their back, and they don’t have a definite cephalothorax and abdomen like spiders do. In spite of what the internet says, they have no venom glands at all, nor can they make silk. Some species of true spiders, like cellar spiders, are also called daddy longlegs in some areas.



The second pair of legs is often longer, and functions as antennae. While spiders can eat only liquids, harvestmen can swallow both chunks and liquids. They eat a wide variety of foods both living and dead, everything from smaller insects to plants and fungi to scat. All species lay eggs, and all have defensive scent glands ward off predators.

In addition to noxious secretions, harvestmen have other defenses. Some will fall to the ground when disturbed. Some will drop legs, which will continue to twitch after separation, attracting predator attention while the harvestman escapes. Losing legs is costly, though, since they cannot be regenerated. So, use care when handling harvestmen.



In some species, the male cares for the eggs, cleaning and protecting them from predators. The eggs may hatch within three weeks to six months. The young molt about six times as they grow. Adults may hang out together near favorable habitats, in groups ranging in size from less than 100 up to 70,000 individuals. These aggregations can be quite scary to people with arachnophobia, but harvestmen are harmless.

Daddy longlegs are another fascinating part of nature that you can find at you Allen County Parks.

Upcoming Programs for Summer

Program fees are usually \$2.00 per person unless otherwise stated, and are used to provide operating funds (which are not supported by tax revenue) for Allen County Parks. Most programs require pre-registration to allow resource and staff allocation planning. There may be requirements for a minimum number registered to offer the program. You will be notified at least 1 day before the program if it has been cancelled due to minimum registrations not being met.
